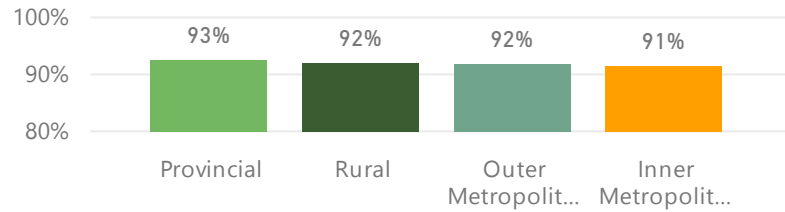
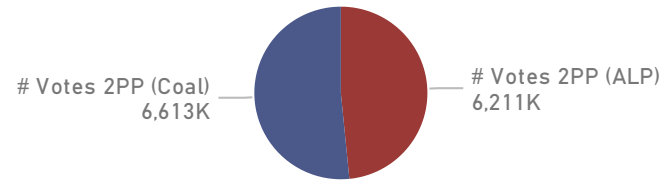


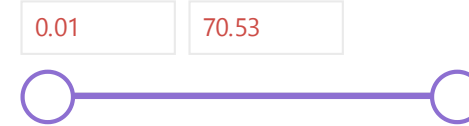
% Turnout by Demographic Rating

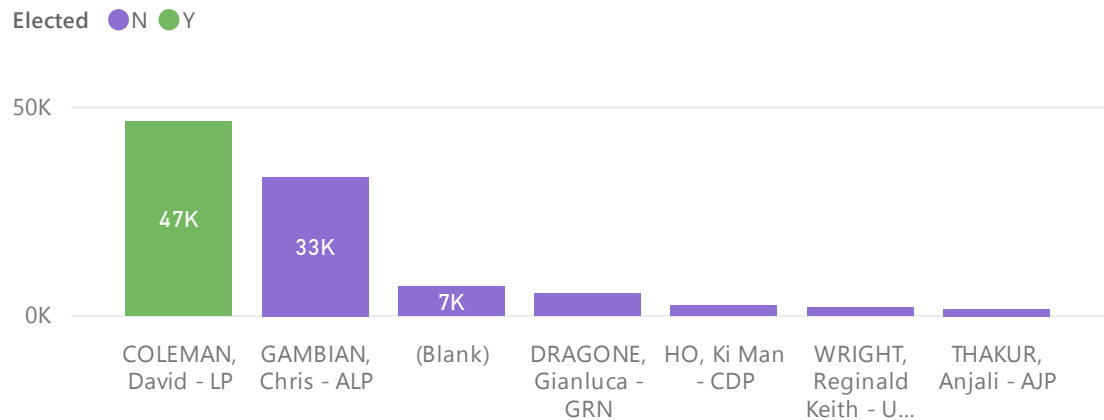

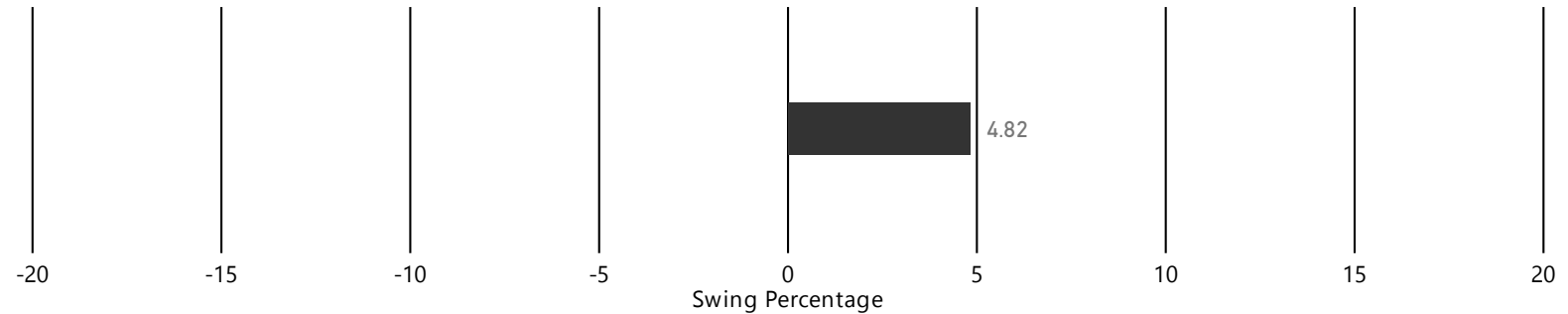
Ordinary Votes by Polling Place
