HALF DAY TRAINING

Sometimes it is difficult for a team to commit to a full day of training because of everyday business activity. CMBI can present any of the one-day courses in two half-day sessions. Typically, we schedule these half-day sessions from 9:30 - 13:30, leaving the team free for the afternoon.

LEARNING METHOD

We present each day's training as a set of tasks that attendees will complete. A folder of materials supports which includes the finished Power BI example, a starting point, and a video and/or course notes explaining the task.

Attendees have these materials on their network/local drive and can create many copies of each. We work through each task interactively during the training with attendees completing the tasks on their computers with our assistance.

Attendees can refer to the video and/or notes post-training to refresh their memory for anything that they have missed. The support materials are primarily a post-training memory aid we do not rely on them during the session. Instead, we walk through and build the examples together throughout the sessions.

PRICING
